

Utilizing The Flip Pad in the AD Report Files

The **AD Compliance Report Tool** files all have a "Flip Pad" available in the upper left corner of the window. Understanding the role of the flip pad can be very helpful when working with AD Report Files.

For example, the number **below** the Flip Pad, indicates how many "records" or ADs are in your report.



The number **beside** the Flip Pad, indicates which AD record (or line) you are currently clicked on and working with.

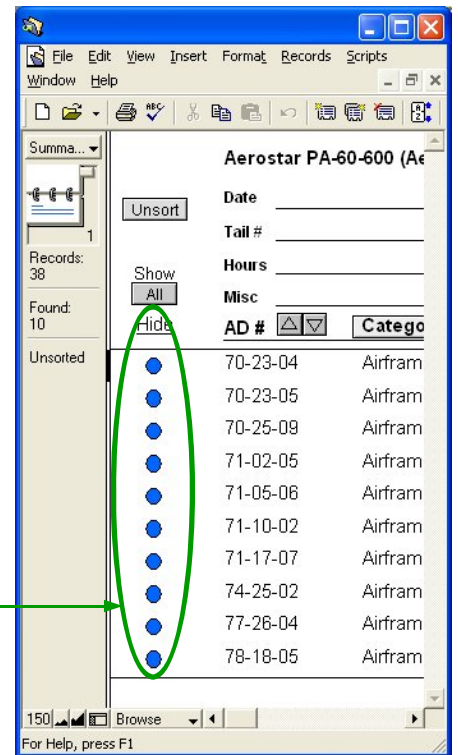
The "Found" section **under** the Flip Pad tells you how many AD records you are currently working with:



When importing records to create a combined category report file, you would see this:

28 original (Airframe ADs) records
+ 10 newly imported (Engine AD) records
= 38 Total

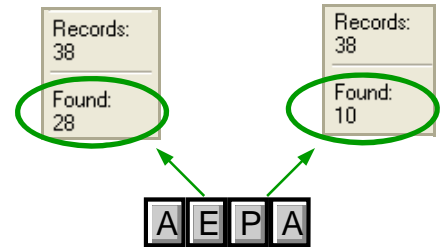
With only the 10 newly imported records showing or "Found".

After clicking "Show All" button, all 38 of the AD Records are brought into view, available to work with, and the "Found" section disappears.

The same thing occurs when you click on the "A E P A" category buttons:
